## Follow Up Guidance During COVID-19 Crisis

The **STS/ACC TVT Registry** mandates that sites complete 30-day and one-year follow up of patients receiving transcatheter valve therapies. However, we realize with the ongoing COVID-19 crisis, face-to-face patient follow up is going to be increasingly difficult.

Therefore, we are suggesting several steps that can be taken to complete the followup visits.

- Consider substituting telephonic or telehealth visits for in-person routine visits.
- Sites may complete the STS/ACC TVT Registry 30-day and one-year follow-up form via telephonic or telehealth visits by collecting the following information:
  - o Patient status
  - o Complete NYHA
  - o Complete KCCQ
  - Has the patient been hospitalized? If so, document reasons for hospitalization. Has the patient seen a local clinician for follow-up? If so, request the records.
  - Did the patient have an echo since the procedure? If so, when and where was the echo performed. Obtain the report if possible.
